






L'Escale is a wordless circus tale, the story of an unexpected encounter between a sailor and a spectator on an imaginary island.

It is in the street that you are most likely to see Simon. Since 2017, he has been transforming public spaces into ephemeral theaters to tell stories, played with poetry and lightness.

Since childhood, circus arts have been part of his life. He studied cinema and visual effects before moving to Berlin in 2015, where the local scene inspired him to turn his passion into a profession.

A circus performer, juggler, and rope walker, he trained by attending various workshops and made his debut on the street. This eventually led him to write L'Escale, a circus tale for young and old, which has been touring street festivals across Europe since 2018.

Between two summer seasons, Simon met Marc Zeun. Together, they founded Roar Circus, an unmissable duo at juggling conventions in Europe and worldwide, known for their zany show "The Roar Circus Show", and especially as masters of ceremonies.

In 2022, he decided to dive into the art of clowning by joining the school 'Le Samovar' in Paris. Along with other students, he co-created a new burlesque company called La Détonnante.

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

Technical sheet L'Escale

- Duration of the show: 30 minutes
- Mounting time: 30 minutes
- Dismounting time: 20 minutes
- Minimum size of the playing area: 8 meters x 6 meters x 4 meters
- Languages: universal
- For for all audiences from 3 years old.
- Audience size: preferably from 50 to 300 persons.
- The show contains fire (fire torches). However, it can be played without.

- The rig of the show is movable. Once mounted, it can be moved out of the playing area without dismounting time.
- There should not be physical border around the playing area (elevated stage, barrier...). Public interaction is the heart of the show.
- The sound equipment is provided with the show (for a capacity of 150 people maximum)
- No benches, bleachers, chairs, or mats for the audience to sit on are provided with the show. If considered necessary, they must be provided by the event organiser.
